Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Medical Council ofIndia (MCI) has recently summoned anumber of doctors to appear before itsEthics Committee over graft charges;
- (b) if so, the details thereof align withthe action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government against the erring doctors;
- (c) whether the Indian MedicalAssociation (IMA) and the Association of Healthcare Providers of India (AHPI) haveconstituted a joint committee to formulatea self-regulatory code for doctors andhospitals in the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the other steps taken/proposed tobe taken by the Government to strengthen the existing regulation in this regard and toensure their proper enforcement and compliance by the doctors in the country?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a) & (b): Yes. The Medical Council of India has informed that they are in receipt of an anonymous complaint, which was referred by the Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilisers, New Delhi. The complaint is against several doctors of receiving cash payment, foreign trips, gifts, etc. from ERIS Life Sciences Pvt. Limited, Ahmedabad. The matter has been placed before the Ethics Committee of the MCI.
- (c) & (d): No such information is available with the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.
- (e): The Indian Medical Council (Professional Conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations, 2002 has already been amended vide notification dated 10th December, 2009 to restrict doctors from accepting gifts/favours from pharmaceutical and allied health sector industry.
