(c) During the year 2011-12 vide letter no. 10785/PM/11/SCSTDD dated 08/8/2011, in 2012-13 vide letter no. 1048/A2/ 2012/BCDD dated 21/6/2012 and in 2013-14 vide letter no. BCDD/A3/422/13(1) dated 16/7/2013, the State Government demanded more than the Allocated funds.

(d) Any additional expenditure incurred by a State/UT beyond the level of Central Assistance according to the Scheme guidelines may be considered for reimbursement by the Central Government, to the extent of availability of savings (mainly from States which are not able to fully avail of their notional allocation, for any reason), towards the end of a financial year. Hence enhancement of Central Assistance to Kerala under the PMS Scheme depends upon the amount of saving towards the end of financial year 2014-15.
