(a): Madam, National Aluminium Company Limited (NALCO) at Angul (Odisha), Sesa Sterlite Group at Jharsuguda (Odisha) & Korba (Chhattisgarh) and Hindalco Industries Limited at Renukoot (Uttar Pradesh), Hirakud (Odisha), Sambalpur (Odisha) and Singaruli (Madhya Pradesh) are the major aluminium producers in the country. There is no Aluminium (producing) Smelter Plant located in the State of Maharashtra. The quantum of aluminium produced by the major aluminium producers during the last three years and current year up to October,2014 are given below:-
