Similarly, as per the National Sample Survey Report No. 543 of MoSPI (2009-10) regarding Worker Population Ratios (WPRs) of various groups and castes, it has been found that there is a general increase of OBCs population share in employment.

Many schemes etc. are being operated by the various Ministries/ Department of the Government of India for the welfare & upliftment of the OBCs. The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment is also providing concessional loans to the OBCs through the National Backward Classes finance and Development Corporation, to enable them to be self- employed. The Ministry is also giving financial assistance to NGOs which are engaged in imparting technical trainings to the OBCs, with a view to make them self-employed.
