Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways propose to release more funds for Salem Division and if so, the action taken by the Railway in this regard; and
- (b) whether the Railway is aware of the incident of a school bus hit by train at an unmanned railway crossing in Medak district in Telangana and if so, the details of the compensation paid to the families of the victim?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) An outlay of `1.5 crore has been provided to the work of 'Salem-Setting up of new division' for the financial year 2014-15, which is considered adequate for the existing level of activities.
- (b) On 24.07.2014 at 09.15 hrs, while the Train No. 57564 Nanded-Hyderabad Passenger was on run between Wadiaram and Masaipet stations in Medak district of Telangana, one school bus dashed against its train engine at unmanned level crossing No. 233-C causing loss of lives.

No claim for compensation is filed/registered before the Railway Claims Tribunal, Secunderabad, hence no compensation has been paid.

However, ex-gratia @ ` 2lakh each to the next of kin of 18 dead persons i.e. ` 36 lakh; and @ 1 lakh each to 18 grievously injured persons i.e. total ` 18 lakh has been paid by the Railways in this accident at unmanned level crossings.
