- (b) whether the project is lagging behind the schedule;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the total funds sanctioned and utilised so far for the project, State-wise?

- (a): Madam, Present Status of the implementation of the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and Systems (CCTNS) project in the country, particularly in Delhi is furnished in the Annexure I.
- (b) & (c): The project is lagging behind the schedule which can be attributed to the following:
- # States/UTs took time in preparation and finalisation of Request for Proposal (RFPs) for selection of State System Integrator (SI).
- # SI selection in some of the States/UTs got delayed.
- # In some of the States/UTs there was delay in handing over the sites to SI.
- # In some of the States/UTs there were issues in execution of project by SI.
- # Delay in establishment of National Data Centre due to technical issues in Core Application Software.
- # Originally developed Core Application Software (CAS) had to undergo lot of changes due to performance issues and additional functional requirements from field units.
- # Delay in commissioning of WiMax and VSAT sites.
- (d): Total funds sanctioned and utilised so far for the project, State/UT-wise is furnished in the Annexure II.
