Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a shortage of police training centres in various States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to address these problems?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI HARIBHAI PARATHIBHAI CHAUDHARY)

- (a): Yes, Madam, there is a shortage of Police Training Centres in various States.
- (b): Presently, there are 215 training institutes in the various States and 72 training institutes are in the Centre. Presently, the capacity of these training institutes is around 20% of the requirement. During the 13th Finance Commission, a proposal was submitted for grant of Rs. 6576 crores to States/UTs, to augment Police Training Infrastructure. But, only Rs.2291 Crores were sanctioned to 21 States.
- (c): The matter for up-gradation and creation of new Training Centre/Institutes, a tentative requirement of Rs.21813 Crore has been submitted before the 14th Finance Commission.
