- (a) to (c): A statement indicating the number of cases registered by the National Human Rights Commission during the last three years and current year upto 25/11/2014 State-wise, alongwith status thereof, on the basis of complaints (petitions) about alleged human rights violations/intimations received, is enclosed at Annexure-A.
- (d): During various workshops, seminars and camp sittings, the Commission makes efforts to sensitize senior officers in State Governments for expediting the response called for by the Commission. The Commission also uses measures such as issue of conditional summons, summons and bailable warrants for expediting the receipt of reports for expeditious disposal of complaints.
