(a) to (c) No organization has specifically come to notice for running an organized movement of alleged bogey of "Love Jihad".

"Public Order' and 'Police' are State subjects as per the provisions of the Constitution of India. The responsibilities of maintaining law and order, registration and prosecution of crimes, including those involving alleged hate speeches etc., primarily rest with the respective State Governments. State Governments are competent to take appropriate action under the provisions of extant laws to deal with such offences.
