- (a) whether Mine Counter Measure Vessels (MCMVs) are deployed to detect, tract and destroy mines laid by enemy forces to choke harbours and spread mayhem;
- (b) if so, whether there is shortage of MCMVs in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the process for acquiring two MCMVs has been started in 2005 but could not be materialised so far and if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps being taken / proposed to be taken to acquire and manufacture such MCMVs without any delay?
