- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the spending on defence to cope up with the latest requirements and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): A comparison of the data on defence spending vis-a-vis that of other countries is difficult due to lack of uniformity in treatment of different components of the expenditure and non-availability of reliable and latest published data. Defence expenditure by major neighbouring countries as published by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) is as under:-
