**Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government defines 'green jobs' on the basis of process or output, and accordingly, the number of green jobs are there in India currently;
- (b) the industries in which the Government is promoting the creation of green jobs and the method adopted for the same; and
- (c) the share of non-renewable energy in India and the manner in which it changed over the last five years including the current year?

**Answer**

(a)&(b): Government has not defined 'green jobs' either on the basis of process or output.

(c): The share of installed capacity of new and renewable energy is about 12.4% of overall installed power generation capacity from all sources. The year wise share of Renewable Energy Sources (RES) and Non-Renewable Energy (non-RES) Sources in the total installed capacity in the country over the last five year is as follows:
