**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether job cards were not issued to the people working under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) in Aurangabad region of Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the action taken/being taken by the Union Government thereon;
- (c) whether the Union Government had made any assessment about the issue of job cards in Ranchi region of Jharkhand; and
- (d) if so, the outcome thereof?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BIRENDER SINGH)

(a) & (b) No, Madam. The State Government of Maharashtra vide letter dated 02.12.2014, has stated that, Job cards have been issued to registered workers in Aurangabad region under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA).

(c) & (d) The Ministry monitors the issue of Job cards by the various States/UTs including Jharkhand through Management Information System (MIS). In Ranchi district, there are 3.06 lakh households registered and were issued Job cards, of which 1.17 lakhs are active and working.
