Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number and percentage of women, Dalit and Adivasi workers provided employment under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) duringeach of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the employment of womenworkers has decreased over the yearsespecially in Uttar Pradesh;
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor and thesteps taken by the Government in this regard;
- (d) whether wide ranging social benefitsand productive assets have been createdunder MGNREGS; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise?

Answer

MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BIRENDER SINGH)

- (a) The persondays generated by women, SCs and STsin absolute and percentage terms as reported by the States/UTs during the last three years and in the current year are given in Annexure-I.
- (b)&(c) The participation of women in the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) has been increasing every year starting from 48.12% (2011-12) to 55.91% (2014-15upto 1st Dec 2014). Even in Uttar Pradesh, where women participation has been below the statutory level of 1/3rd, there has been steady improvement from 17.18% (2011-12) to 24.70% (2014-15 upto 1st Dec 2014). With a view to improving Women participation in UP, it has been suggested vide Advisory dated 7th Aug 2014 to plan for improving the women participation by identifying Mates from best women workers, open bank accounts for all women workers and by developing separate schedule of rates for women dominated work.
- (d) & (e) The MGNREGS has succeeded in creating several community and individual assets such as bringinng fallow lands into cultiva- tion, creating irrigation sources or renovating the existing sour- ces, developing horticulture and afforestation, formation of rural roads etc. The details of works completed under MGNREGA, State/ UT-wise during the last three years and in the current year are given in Annexure-II.
