(c) BSNL has planned to add 645 Node Bs (3G) and 1109 Base Transceiver Stations (BTSs) (2G) and associated core equipment in Rajasthan circle under its phase VII GSM expansion project. Out of this planned addition, BSNL has already installed 218 Node Bs and 575 BTSs (2G).
