## Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has conducted any study on the regions facing agrarian crisis in the country;

(b) if so, the details and the outcome thereof; and

(c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to encourage the use of modern agriculture techniques to sustain growth of agriculture to solve the problem of agrarian crisis in the country?

## Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MOHANBHAI KUNDARIA)

(a) & (b): Government has not conducted any such study as agriculture is a state subject under the Constitution and the States are primarily responsible for development of agriculture sector including welfare of farmers.

(c): Government of India is implementing National Mission on Agricultural Extension and Technology (NMAET). Under this Mission, a Sub-Mission on Agricultural Mechanization (SMAM) is implemented in all the States and UTs with the objectives to increase the reach of farm mechanization; promote 'Custom Hiring Centres'; create hubs for hi-tech & high value farm equipments; create awareness among stakeholders through demonstration and capacity building; and ensure performance testing and certification at designated testing centres.

The major interventions/components of SMAM are:-

- (i) Promotion and Strengthening of agricultural mechanization through training, testing and demonstration;
- (ii) Demonstration, training and distribution of post harvest technology and management;
- (iii) Financial assistance for procurement of agriculture machinery and equipment;
- (iv) Establishment of farm machinery banks for custom hiring;
- (v) Establishment of hi-tech, high productive equipment hub for custom hiring;
- (vi) Promotion of farm mechanization in selected villages;
- (vii) Financial assistance for promotion of mechanized operations carried out through custom hiring centers; and
- (viii) Promotion of farm machinery and equipment in North-Eastern Region.
