(a) & (b) Yes Madam, A National Plan of Action for Hilsa with involvement of several stakeholders including State Governments is under implementation. The Central and the State Governments have conservation policies through various legislation to improve the Hilsa Fishery in the country. Among them are important amendments brought into the West Bengal Marine Fisheries Regulation Act 1993 and West Bengal Inland Fisheries Rule 1985. Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) has taken up a project on stock characterization, captive breeding, seed production and culture of hilsa involving 7 Research Institutions.
