(a) whether there has been a shortfall in honey production from honey/bees in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof and reasons therefor; and

(c) the details of steps taken/being taken by the Government to promote the production of honey bees?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI MOHANBHAI KUNDARIA)

(a) to (c): There is no shortfall reported in honey production from honeybees in the country. However, the Government has taken the following steps to promote the production of honey/bee keeping by providing financial assistance under pollination support through beekeeping, a component of Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH).

i) production of nucleus stock of honey bees,

ii) production of honey bee colonies by bee breeders,

iii) distribution of honeybee colonies & beehives,

iv) distribution of a complete set of beekeeping equipments, including honey extractor, food grade plastic containers, honey extraction net, etc.

v) various capacity building programmes i.e. trainings/seminars/workshops etc.

In addition, Government has reconstituted the National Bee Board (NBB) for development of scientific beekeeping.
