(b) the details of the achievements made by these research institutes during the last three years and the current year, institution-wise and project-wise;

(c) the details of the future plan chalked out by the Government on agricultural research activities; and

(d) whether the Government proposes to increase the fund on these research institutions during the 12th Five Year Plan period, if so, the details thereof?

# Answer

(a) The Plan expenditure of DARE/ICAR on the agricultural research activities during the last three years and the current year is as under:-

(b) There are 67 Institutes including 04 Deemed Universities, 15 National Research Centres, 14 Directorates, 06 National Bureaux & 641 Krishi Vigyan Kendras under DARE/ICAR. All our research activities are being carried out through these Institutes and their research achievement are being monitored by the respective Subject Matter Divisions, which are summarized in Annexure-I.

(c) Details are given in Annexure-II.

(d) The XII Plan working group constituted by Planning Commission had recommended Rs.55,000/- crores as XII Plan Outlay to the Department of Agricultural Research and Education/Indian Council of Agricultural Research (DARE/ICAR) against the XII Plan Outlay proposed by DARE/ICAR to the tune of Rs.57,887.21 crores. The Planning Commission has communicated Rs.25,553.00 crores to DARE/ICAR during XII Plan which is a significant increase over the XI Plan outlay of Rs.12,023.00 crores.
