- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to transfer cash subsidy to accounts of Below Poverty Line (BPL) card-holders, poor people and destitute in place of the ration provided to them;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the said proposal is likely to be implemented; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): No, Madam. The issues of entitlement under the Targeted Public Distribution System are complex. Hence, there is no proposal at present under consideration of the Government to transfer food subsidy in cash in place of foodgrains to accounts of Below Poverty Line (BPL) card-holders, poor people and destitutes.
