- (a) & (b): No, Madam. Crop insurance is compulsory for loanee farmers and optional for non-loanee. However, the premium rates are same for the same crop.
- (c ): The Crop Insurance Schemes are continually reviewed and improvements, wherever possible, are carried out to better serve the interest of farmers.
