- (a)&(b): Yes, Madam. During the recent meetings held with Members of Parliament on matter relating to Southern Railway in November, 2014, various proposals were received from Hon'ble Members of Parliament, such as, introduction of new trains, provision of stoppages of trains, construction of road-over bridges/road-under bridges, early completion of doubling/gauge conversion work, setting up of coach factories in Tamil Nadu, laying of new lines, etc.
- (c): Whenever suggestions are received from Hon'ble Members of Parliament by Zonal Railways during such meetings or otherwise, the same are examined and suitable action is taken. It is an ongoing and continuous process.
