(a): A survey for laying a new line between Secunderabad- Karimnagar via Siddipet was included in the Railway Budget 2011-12. The same was, however, dropped as two new line projects namely Manoharabad- Kottapalli via Siddipet and Nizamabad - Jagityal providing connectivity between Secunderabad and Karimnagar were sanctioned and execution also taken up. Both these lines, will provide two new alternate routes between Secunderabad and Karimnagar with one route via Siddipet.
