- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether reduction in purchase by Railways is resulting in loss to engineering industry in Karnataka;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the time by which its pending projects are likely to be completed ?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 4656 BY SHRI SHIVKUMAR UDASI TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 22.12.2014 REGARDING COMPLETION OF RAILWAY PROJECTS.

(a) and (b): Allotment of funds for Railway projects is not done State-wise. In view of huge throwforward of ongoing projects and limited overall availability of funds, it has not been possible to provide adequate funds to all the projects including those falling fully/partly in the State of Karnataka. However, the details of allocation made in 2014-15 for major projects are as under:-

New Line Rs. 907 crore
Doubling Rs. 636 crore
Railway Rs. 110 crore
Electrification
Workshops Rs. 42 crore

(c) and (d): No data is maintained in this regard by Ministry of Railways.

(e): Due to huge throwforward of ongoing projects and limited availability of funds, time frame for completion of all the projects cannot be fixed.
