(a) to (d): In the last Home Secretary level talks held between India and Bangladesh in September, 2014 at Dhaka, security related issues including issues of fugitives were discussed. Both sides exchanged the lists of fugitives and Red Corner Notice subjects wanted by either country. Both sides agreed to keep a close vigil on fugitives and Red Corner Notice subjects with enhanced cooperation between the Interpol Nodal Points.
