- (a) The details of existing norms/criteria fixed for recommending/nominating eligible sportspersons for Arjuna Award and other sports awards viz. Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna, Dronacharya Awards and Dhyan Chand Awards are as under:
- S. No. Name of the Award Eligibility criteria
- 1. Arjuna Award A sportsperson should have had not only good performance over the previous four years at the International level but also should have shown qualities of leadership, sportsmanship and a sense of discipline
- 2. Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna The spectacular and most outstanding performance in the field of sports by a sports person over a period of four years immediately preceding the year during which award is to be given for excellence at international level i.e. Olympics/Asian/ Commonwealth/WorldGames/ Championships/ World Cup and
 - Championships/ World Cup and equivalent recognized international tournaments
- 3 Dronacharya Award
 Coach, whether he/she works
 full time or part time as coach,
 should have produced outstanding
 achievement over a period of four

years immediately preceding the year in which the award is to be given.

For 2 awards earmarked for lifetime contribution in coaching, achievements of the coach in producing outstanding sportspersons over a period of 20 years or more will be taken into

account.

- 4 Dhyan Chand Award A sportsperson should have had not only good performance at international level but also should have continued to contribute to promotion of sports in his individual capacity even after his career as a sportsperson is over.
- A sportsperson should also have shown qualities of leadership, sportsmanship and sense of discipline.
