INSTRUMENT LANDING SYSTEM AT IGI AIRPORT

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any instances of malfunctioning of Instrument Landing System at Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport resulting in diversion/cancellation of flights have come to the notice of the Government;
- (b) if so, the details of such instances reported at IGI Airport during the last three years and the current year along with the action taken by the Government thereon; and
- (c) the steps taken or being taken by the Government to avoid recurrence of such instances in future?

Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Dr. Mahesh Sharma)

- (a): No, Madam. Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport is equipped with 6 Instrument Landing System (ILS). Runway 11, 28 and 29 are equipped with Category (CAT)-III (B) ILS and Runway 09, 10 and 27 are equipped with CAT-I ILS. In case of non-availability/ non-functioning of ILS on any runway, other navigational aids installed on same runway are used to facilitate uninterrupted arrivals at the airports.
