Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is always a risk involved in take-off and landing of flights at Patna Airport runway due to its short length;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to extend the length of Patna airport runway; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which extension work of the said runway is likely to start and be completed?

Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Dr. Mahesh Sharma)

- (a): Patna Airport is a constrained airport. Airlines plan their operations based on the declared distance published in NOTAM/AIP, which indicates the take-off run available, take-off distance available, accelerate-stop distance available and landing distance available.
- (b) & (c): Expansion of runway is not feasible due to air-side limitation, land constraints and obstacles such as Railway line and Highway towards west and Botanical Garden, Government buildings and Watch Tower towards east.
