(b): Number of retired employees re-employed in the year 2012 is 18, in 2013 is 06 and in 2014 is 05. All the 29 retired execu- tives were kept on contract on specific assignments to impart training to newly appointed Air Traffic Controllers and in other important areas.;

(c): Airports Authority of India (AAI) undertakes action for recruitment at Junior Executive, Manager and Deputy General Manager level in various disciplines as per requirement. The consultants deployed to undertake specific job are of senior level. AAI reviews from time to time, the number of consultants appointed when the Executives are eligible for their promotion to senior level.
