CONSTRUCTION OF NEW STATIONS

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the present status of feasibility study for opening of a halt station at Dera Baba Rudranand between Una and Ghandwal railway stations;
- (b) whether the Railways propose to set up a new station at Samarthwadi between Badlapur and Vangani stations under Central Railway and to set up a second railway terminal at Kollam railway station;
- (c) if so, the details and the present status thereof;
- (d) whether the Railways propose to expand the platforms at Wardha station and also improve the amenities; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a): Opening of a halt station at Dera Baba Rudranand between Una Himachal and Ghandwal railway stations has been examined but not found commercially viable.
- (b): No, Madam.
- (c): Does not arise.
- (d) & (e): Wardha Railway Station has been provided with all essential amenities as per norms and has been developed under Adarsh stations scheme. There is no proposal, at present, for expanding platforms/amenities at Wardha station.
