(a)to(c): New projects are being planned with available latest technologies. New technologies are adopted whenever these projects became operational. In opencast mines bigger and higher capacity machineries like 42 Cum shovel, 240 tonner dumpers, 800 HP dozers, 380 mm drill, Surface Miners, 500 HP grader have been introduced. As a result there is continuous increase of production from open cast mines of Coal India Ltd. (CIL). Company-wise coal production from Open cast mines during last three years and the current year is at Annex. In underground mines new technologies like continuous miners, long wall / short wall mining, high wall mining etc. have been introduced where ever geo mining condition permitted.
