(i) Organisation of book fairs and book exhibitions across the country
(ii) Participation in Book Fairs organized by various Publishers Associations
(iii) Organisation of annual New Delhi World Book Fair
(iv) Publications of reasonably priced quality books for general readers and children
(v) The Scheme of Financial Assistance to Voluntary
Organisations and professional bodies of publishers and writers for organizing seminars, conferences of writers / publishers/ printers / booksellers related to book promotion and publishing.
