Title: Regarding death of eleven activits of the Trinamool Congress Party in Khujutipara village in Birbhum district of West Bengal.

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY (CALCUTTA NORTH WEST): Sir, 11 Trinamool Congress members in Khujutipara village under Nanur Police Station in the district of Birbhum were brutally killed by CPI (M) this morning at 11 o' clock. ...(Interruptions) You please hear me for a moment....(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: Nothing will go on record except the speech of Shri Sudip Bandyopadhyay.

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY: All of them belong to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and minority communities. They are being tortured and killed at random by CPI (M) people. It is a pre-planned and motivated attack. Our leader, Kumari Mamata Banerjee is leaving this afternoon to visit the spot, to attend the funeral and to console the bereaved families.

There is a Constitutional breakdown. Parliamentary democracy system in West Bengal is under serious threat. There is utter lawlessness.

MR. SPEAKER: The Law Minister is here. He is going to reply you. What is this?

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY: The hon. Home Minister is here. I draw his attention to this matter. This cannot be treated as a State subject.
