Title: Need to provide financial assistance to the Government of Maharashtra for making Nag Nadi and Peeli Nadi at Nagpur pollution free – Laid.

SHRI VILAS MUTTEMWAR (NAGPUR): The Nag Nadi and Peeli Nadi which are passing through the Nagpur city have been posing a great threat to the health of the people of the city. Acute insanitary conditions have been created as a result of the industrial and other waste which gets accumulated in these rivers. While during rainy season this waste gets washed away because of the heavy flow of water but at other times the waste remains accumulated in these rivers and is a health hazard to a large population. The National Environment and Engineering Research Institute (NERRI) conducted a detailed study to revive these rivers for providing clean water to the city but the reports of the institute are yet to be implemented by the Government.

I would urge upon the Government to kindly extend all the assistance to the State Governments, financial or otherwise, in the implementation of the reports of NEERI so as to revive these rivers with a view to provide safe drinking water to the people of Nagpur and to keep them pollution-free.
