"That this House concurs in the recommendation of the Lok Sabha that the Rajya Sabha do appoint two Members of Rajya Sabha to the Joint Committee of the Houses on the Bill to provide for the constitution of a Central Vigilance Commission to inquire or cause inquiries to be conducted into offences alleged to have been committed under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1998 by certain categories of public servants of the Central Government, Corporations established by or under any Central Act, Government companies, societies and local authorities owned or controlled by the Central Government and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto, in the vacancies caused by retirement of two Members namely Shri Hansraj Bhardwaj and Shri Sanjay Nirupam from Rajya Sabha on the 2nd April, 2000 and resolves that Shri Hansraj Bhardwaj and Shri Sanjay Nirupam elected to the Rajya on the 3rd April, 2000 be appointed to the said Joint Committee to fill the vacancies."
