Title: Need for early clearance of Kombai-Kerala and Devaram-Kerala link road projects of Kerala Government-Laid.

SHRI T.T.V. DHINAKARAN (PERIYALULAM): Lots of fruits and other agricultural products are transported from my constituency periyakulam in Tamil Nadu to Kerala. There is a lot of trading activities with Kerala. In view of the heavy traffic to Kerala, two link roads were proposed to connect Kerala. one from Devaram. Schemes were drawn up to construct these roads. One road from Kombai near Cumbum would connect Tamil Nadu with Kerala through Ramakkal Mettu link road. The other road connect Devaram near Bodi, with Kerala via Sakulathumettu link road. These two roads when constructed would remove the inconvenience caused, not only to the people of the area, but to the people of both Tamil Nadu and Kerala.

But these two link road projects are pending with the Ministry of Environment and Forests for clearance.

In view of the importance and urgency of the matter, I request the Government to clear both road projects immediately.
