

Title: Need to fence the Indo-Bangladesh border in Tripura.

SHRI KHAGEN DAS (TRIPURA-WEST): Sir, the construction of border fencing along the Indo-Bangladesh border in Tripura is very critical for containing extremist activities...(Interruptions) The State Government has been requesting for expediting the work...(Interruptions)

SHRI KHAGEN DAS : Sir, so far the work has been very slow. Sometimes the implementing agencies are facing problems due to resistance being offered by Bangladesh Rifles... (Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: Please do not interrupt him. Not much time is left.

SHRI KHAGEN DAS : In a recent incident in Kathalsori in South Tripura district, the *jawans* of the Bangladesh Rifles had opened fire on the workers engaged in fencing work. Work has been stopped due to this. This issue of interference by the Bangladesh Rifles should be taken up immediately with the Bangladesh authorities...(Interruptions)

MR. SPEAKER: It is a very important issue.

SHRI KHAGEN DAS : It is estimated that over seven thousand families would be affected by this. Adequate rehabilitation should be provided to the affected families on humanitarian ground. A number of agencies are involved in undertaking this work. It has also been reported that quality of work has not been up to the mark. There should not be any compromise on quality. I would like to request that a team of qualified supervisors should be sent to the State to undertake inspection of the construction work.
