Title: Need to take steps to check atrocities on Dalits and set up a separate Ministry for the welfare of Backward Caste people. – Laid.

Atrocities against Dalits as well as unsociability are on the increase across the country. Crimes against a Dalit youth in Bedkalan village in Pali district of Rajasthan and a Dalit woman in Munger district in Bihar are some of the reported incidents.

I urge upon the Government to set up BC department and form a Ministry specially for BC welfare.
