SHRI PAWAN KUMAR BANSAL: Mr. Deputy-Speaker, Sir, Chandigarh, the joint Capital of Punjab and Haryana, and the headquarters of the Union Territory, with its prestigious institutions like the Punjab University, the Post-Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, the Punjab Engineering College, the College of Architecture and the College of Arts, the Indian Institute of Microbial Technology and the Central Scientific Instruments Organisation, is a city which has become a centre of excellence in many fields, particularly, education and research.
