Title: Regarding need to address problems of the Anglo – Indian community.

SHRI FRANCIS FANTHOME (NOMINATED): Sir, The 42 nd Report of the National Commissioner Linguistic Minorities does not include any reference to the concerns and problems of the Anglo-India community – a linguistic minority community defined in the Constitution.

In the reports from the various states the following concerns of this community have not been addressed:

- Certain states reply to representations only in the states official language which puts the minority community at considerable disadvantage.
- 2. The schools established and administered by the states do not provide for curriculum transaction in the language of the minorities.
- 3. There is no registration of language preference of linguistic minority pupils.
- 4. There is no notified machinery to examine and address the concerns of the Anglo-Indian community.

Consequently, the Anglo-Indian community is at considerable disadvantage in the states.

I request the Government to look into the matter.
