Title: Need to provide basic infrastructural facilities at Sunderbans Wildlife area in West Bengal.

SHRI SANAT KUMAR MANDAL (JOYNAGAR): I wish to bring to the notice of the Government the importance of developing the Sunderbans Wildlife area/National Park in the perspective of eco-tourism as it has an immense potential to bring both the national/international tourists as well as revenue in the foreign exchange.

Though Sunderbans Wildlife area, the core of the largest delta/largest mangrove forest in the planet, has been declared as a National Park, the infrastructural and other facilities available for the visiting tourists are not at par with other National Parks of the country.
