Title: Need to pay fifty percent share of profit earned on oil and gas produced from Rajasthan to the Government of Rajasthan for the development of the State.

SHRI DUSHYANT SINGH (JHALAWAR): Western part of Rajasthan is a desertic terrain and availability of infrastructure in the region is improving. This region has rich mineral potential particularly petroleum. This has been proved by a recent discovery of oil in Barmer-Sarchor basin and gas field in Jaisalmer district.

By exploitation of oil in the state local people are affected. Central Government gets profit from these resources as "profit petroleum". These resources are lying in the State and State Government should get its due share for the development and welfare of local people.

Thus, I request the Government of India that income of profit generated from petroleum, 50%% share should be paid to the State Government from the mineral oil & gas produced from the State.
