Title: Need to grant travel concession in trains to handicapped persons, senior citizens and their

escorts.

SHRI LONAPPAN NAMBADAN (MUKUNDAPURAM): Sir, I rise to bring to the notice of the

Central Government the matter regarding grant of 100 per cent travel concession in trains to the

blind, deaf and dump persons and also to the handicapped persons who are having 50 per cent or

more disability. The persons who accompany them as escorts should also be allowed such

concessions.

Similarly, all the senior citizens should be allowed the travel concession to the extent of

75 per cent and besides, the senior citizens above 70 years of age should also be allowed to take a

help or escort with them at 75 per cent rate.

It is not possible for all the people to afford to take dead bodies of the relatives by

aeroplane from the place of work to their hometown. Transit of dead bodies by train should be

allowed free of cost, along with at least two persons who accompany the body. The concession

now being allowed to poor patients from the downtrodden categories and economically poor

segments of the population should be increased to 100 per cent.

I urge upon the Government to take necessary steps to ensure that the above mentioned

concessions are granted at the earliest.
