Title : Statement regarding status of implementation of recommendations contained in 160<sup>th</sup> Report of Standing Committee on Human Resource Development on Demands for Grants 2005-06 pertaining to Ministry of Women and Child Development.

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI RENUKA CHOWDHURY): I
