Title : Need to accord sanction for opening of a Kendriya Vidyalaya at Bhadrak district in Orissa.

SHRI ARJUN SETHI (BHADRAK): It is a matter of great significance that the Government of India have decided to open a large number of Kendriya Vidyalayas all over the country. I being the representative of the people of Bhadrak district of Orissa state; I deem it my responsibility to bring to your kind notice and the notice of the august House as well that Bhadrak has no Kendriya Vidyalaya at present. Many times I have had drawn the attentions of the Government at the centre as well as the personal attention of the Hon'ble Minister of Human Resource Development. However, in one of his replies to my letter addressed to his personal self Hon'ble Minister has assured me "that the proposal for opening a Kendriya Vidyalaya at Bhadrak has been included in the list of mature Proposals that fulfill all requisites for setting up a new K.V. and a final decision will be taken soon."

The current year academic session has already begun and admission process to be over soon. Unless the decision to open the Kendriya Vidyalaya at Bhadrak district is taken immediately we shall have to wait for another year.

Therefore, I urge upon the Government to accord the sanction of opening the much needed Kendriya Vidyalaya at Bhadrak immediately to facilitate admission of students in the current academic year 2006-07, and to solve the long standing demand of the people in my constituency.
