Title : Regarding termination of services of nurses of Appolo Hospital for speaking Malayalam in the Hospital.

SHRI K. FRANCIS GEORGE (IDUKKI):Sir These nurses working at Appolo Hospital, New Delhi had been terminated from service for speaking Malayalam, their mother tongue, between themselves.

The director of Appolo Hospital has banned Malayalam in the Hospital where 90% of the staff are Keralites, where there is no such bar for other regional languages. The stand of the Appolo Management is highly objectionable as Malayam is a language included in the 8<sup>th</sup> Schedule of our Constitution.

Government of India should take suitable action against the Appolo Management and given instructions to all employees in the country to respect all the languages in the country.
