Title: Reported poor quality of barbed wire fencing of Indo-Bangla border in Barak valley.

SHRI LALIT MOHAN SUKLABAIDYA (KARIMGANJ): Through you, Sir, I want to draw the attention of the Home Minister to a very important matter relating to Indo-Bangla border of Barak Valley. Barbed wire fencing in the Indo-Bangla border in Barak Valley is under severe criticism alleging for its poor quality of work. This issue has been the headline of local newspapers. People of the Valley consider this work as a very important work for their protection from the Bangladesh infiltrators, terrorists, anti-nationalists, even from dacoits and thieves. People often complain about the very poor quality of the work. I have earlier informed the Government also. I do not know as to whether the Government has appointed any third party for inspection or the assessment of the work and as to whether the work has been done according to the specifications or not and as to whether it is fit for the purpose for which it is constructed. Hence, I would request the Government to take action in this regard.

I have one more point to make.
