Title: Need to construct roads in the remote and strategically important border areas of Arunachal Pradesh - laid.

SHRI KIREN RIJJU (ARUNACHAL WEST): Arunachal Pradesh is strategically very important State. The roads in the forward border areas must be constructed at the earliest to meet any challenge and facilitate the local people. Some areas like upper region of West Kameng, East Kameng and Kurung Kumey districts of Arunachal Pradesh are still unconnected with roads. These areas have been left out under the road making programmes of the Government of India. There has been demand from the State Government to construct roads in the remote and strategically important border areas of Arunachal Pradesh.

I would like to request the Minister of Defence to take immediate steps to construct the following roads through Border Roads Organisation:-

- .1 Roads from 9 miles of Bomdila-Dirang road to Nafra and connecting it with Mago-Thingbu in Tawang district.
- .2 Road from Nafra to Lada in East Kameng district and connecting it to Sarli in Kurung kumey district.
- .3 Road from Chayangtajo in East Kameng to Koloriang in Kurung Kumey district.
