THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE): Sir, I am happy to inform the House that the High Commission of India in Islamabad has been informed a little while ago by the Pakistani Foreign Office that the President of Pakistan has stayed the execution of Sarabjit Singh till 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2008 that is a postponement by one month.

As the hon. Members have expressed their concerns yesterday and as I assured them, the Government of India is continuing its efforts to save the life of Sarabjit Singh. We have achieved partial success but we shall continue to carry on our efforts so that his life can be saved.
