Title: Need to construct a four lane road from Yadgirigutta to Eturunagaram in Andhra Pradesh.

SHRI RAJAIAH SIRICILLA (WARANGAL): I would like to draw the attention of the Government towards the dire need to sanction four lane road on NH-202 from Yadgirigutta to Yeturunagaram.

I would like to state that Warangal District of Andhra Pradesh is the 4th biggest town in the State and second biggest town in the Telangana Region of Andhra Pradesh. Moreover, Warangal is a historical place and it was headquarters of Kakatiya dynasty. There are a number of Tourist destinations like temples, lakes, forts and wild life sanctuary. In addition to these, there are a number of educational institutions which are offering education to students not only from all over the country but also from abroad. The Warangal Town is centrally located and it is on National Highway 202. It possess Kazipet Railway Junction which is located on mainline of Kashmir-Kanyakumari. Very recently, a bridge on Godavari at Eturunagaram was sanctioned with a cost of Rs. 300 Cr. and it is under construction. It will connect the Chhattisgarh State also. A four lane road is already sanctioned from Hyderabad to Yadgirigutta. The balance stretch from Yadgirigutta to Eturunagaram, will connect Southern and Northern parts of our country. It is not out of place to mention that the Warangal District is under LWE.

In view of the above, I request the Hon'ble Minister for Road Transport & Highways, to consider for sanction of four lane road from Yadgirigutta to Eturunagaram.
